Chairman Gentry called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. with five voting members being present at that time by roll call. There was a quorum present

Minutes: "Larry Robeson moved, seconded by Rick Cantrell, to approve the Minutes of the October 18, 2004, Stormwater Advisory Committee meeting with one change in Paragraph 1 of Review of the Draft Rutherford County Stormwater Ordinance. This motion passed unanimously by acclamation."

Del Corbitt announced that the new Rutherford County Stormwater Management Ordinance had been adopted by the Board of Commissioners on December 16, 2004, and thanked the committee for their hard work in preparing the ordinance.

Del Corbitt introduced Todd Sullivan as the engineer hired to handle Stormwater issues. The new fee schedule for Land Disturbance was explained.

Progress is being made in being involved in Project WET.

The County will be utilizing a post construction BMP manual from UT.

There was some discussion of whether public utilities should be required to pay a land disturbance fee and put erosion control measures into place. Del Corbitt is to come up with wording for the new ordinance to cover this issue.

Discussion ended at 7:30 p.m. with a motion to adjourn made and seconded. The next meeting date is set for the third Tuesday in July. Chairman Gentry thanked everyone for their work on the draft ordinance and declared the meeting adjourned at 7:37 p.m.
