Minutes: "Mayo Taylor moved, seconded by Karen Hargrove, to approve the Minutes of the July 20, 2004, Stormwater Advisory Committee meeting. This motion passed unanimously by acclamation."

Review of pages 16-27 of the Draft Rutherford County Stormwater Ordinance:

Discussion began on page 13 (4). Application for a land disturbance permit. (8) There was discussion of how performance bonds are determined and secured. It was decided to put a question mark by this to discuss with Del Corbitt.

Discussion moved to issuance of permits. Does Rutherford County want to issue permits, or use the state permit and NOI as some of the municipalities do? Included in these discussions were bonding questions and comments. This item and others were tabled to talk to Del Corbitt about and see what his intentions are in various permitting, bonding, and water quality issues.

Discussion ended at 8:20 p.m. with a motion to adjourn made and seconded. Acting Chair Boyett declared the meeting adjourned at 8:22 p.m.
