Tommy Gentry presided and called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m. with four voting members being present at that time by roll call. Robert Haley, Stormwater Engineer for the City of Murfreesboro was introduced.

Minutes: "Karen Hargrove moved, seconded by Carter Woodruff, to approve the Minutes of the August 17, 2004, Stormwater Advisory Committee meeting with changes. This motion passed unanimously by acclamation."

Review of the Draft Rutherford County Stormwater Ordinance: Discussion began on page 14, Section 4(7) Notice of Construction. Del Corbitt explained the current requirements for road and drainage bonds in the county. Currently as-built plans are not required, but if this regulation is passed as is, as-built plans will become a requirement. Mr. Corbitt also stated his intentions of using a copy of the state permit and NOIs submitted to the state as the county permit.

The process of approval for the draft Stormwater Ordinance was outlined. After this committee recommends approval, the draft will go to the Rutherford County Planning Commission, the Budget Committee, the Public Works Committee, and finally to the Rutherford County Board of Commissioners. Members of this committee will be sent a notice giving specific dates of meetings where the draft Stormwater Ordinance will be under consideration.

Committee members present agreed to meet quarterly following the October meeting unless pressing business dictates an earlier date.

Discussion ended at 8:00 p.m. with a motion to adjourn made and seconded. Chairman Gentry declared the meeting adjourned at 8:03 p.m.
